- 1 Through the Ottawa Network for Education, JA Ottawa reached 5,914 students last year.
- 2 503 student entrepreneurs were inspired in 2018-19, up 18% from the previous year.
- 3 Last year we engaged 470 volunteers, primarily from Ottawa's business community.

Offered at no cost to students or schools, JA programs are accessible and empower every student to take charge of their personal finances, prepare for the work force, and create jobs by starting their own businesses.

According to a recent study by the Boston Consulting Group, JA students are:

- 50% more likely to open their own business
- 3x more likely to hold management positions
- 25% less likely to be unemployed
- 3x more likely to spend less than they earn
